

Forensic Fluids

- Opened in 2005 in the old Gibson Guitar building
- Started in 5,000sqft moved to 30,000 sqft in 2017
- Started with 1 employee, currently 78 employees
- Contracts with both MI DHHS, IN DCS, WIDHS and 60 ODJFS
- Perform drug testing in 27 States
- lacktriangleright We detect drugs of abuse and Therapeutic drugs

Forensic Fluids

- Specializing in Oral Fluid drug testing since 2005
- Extensive Drug List Over 140 compounds
- LC/MS/MS technology to confidently quantitate levels as low as 0.1ng/mL
- 🌢 18 to 24 hour turnaround time
- Criminal Justice, MSP Roadside, and Healthcare
- We test over 2,000 samples per day



Forensic Fluids

- Bridget Lorenz Lemberg Lab Director/Toxicologist
- BS 1982 Food Science MS 1987 Toxicology UK
- Worked: KY State Police Crime Lab, South Bend Med Foundation (urine testing), CST & ASL oral fluid testing
- Arried a WMU professor in December 2004
- Opened FFL 2005, I testify in court over 300 times a year
- FFL has published 3 papers and our Research focus: Lead Pb, Seizure Meds, Impairment, blood/oral correlation



Drug Testing Options

- Oral Fluid and Blood and Breath
 - Actual levels (immediate use, up to four days) *
-) Urine


Hair

- Measures metabolites /past use (several hours after use, up to four/five days) *
- Meconium
 - Chronic drug consumption in the last trimester of pregnancy *
 - Indication of chronic use only, 1.5 inches of hair = 90 days *
 - * Peer reviewed papers available



Window of Detection

HYDROCODONE DETECTION PERIOD IN URINE, ORAL FLUID, AND BLOOD





Oral Fluid Testing

Non invasive, easily obtained, fast collection time, no facilities needed or specialize personnel, preserves dignity

Drug concentrations in saliva are proportional to drug concentrations in plasma/blood

If observed correctly, eliminates cheating

OPIATES (Heroin/6MAM, Morphine, Codeine)


COCAINE (Cocaine, Benzoylecgonine, Ecgonine methyl ester, Cocaethylene)







False Positives/Screen





What does LCMSMS mean?

Liquid Chromatography, Tandem Mass Spectrometry

It identifies drugs by their "fingerprint"

Each drug has a unique structure






LC/MS/MS

Liquid Chromatography/Tandem Mass Spectrometry (LC/MS/MS).

LC/MS/MS or "Confirmation testing" is analytically precise and extremely accurate, by measuring the specific molecular mass, and the concentration (amount) of any drug(s), in a sample. The testing identifies not only the parent drug but also its metabolites. Thus providing data on the exact drug and amount of drug found.
